### **Job Statement**

IndyAct is a global league of independent environmental, cultural and social activists. IndyAct is currently focusing its operations in the Arab World. Although it is a new organization, IndyAct has already established several campaigns in the Arab region, especially Lebanon, on issues such as climate change, resource management, marine and coastal protection, and youth and women’s rights. IndyAct has launched in Aug07 the “Arab Climate Campaign”, which is an advocacy campaign focused on the Arab League’s post-2012 climate policy.
